Important:

- 1. If a student is suspended as a result of violation of rules / regulations of the College and subsequently returns to College, another violation may result in **dismissal**. Re-admission for the subsequent year will be withheld.
- 2. **Suspension** is a sanction that terminates the student's enrollment for a specified period of time. **Dismissal** is a sanction which permanently separates the student from the College without any opportunity to re-enroll in the future.
- 3. A student who has been dismissed or suspended from the College is denied all privileges afforded as a student and must vacate campus at a time determined by the Principal. In addition, he/she may not enter College campus/or other College property at any time for any reason in the absence of the express written consent of the Principal.
- 4. All the members of the staff are empowered to enforce the disciplinary norms

Dress Code

All the students are required to abide by the dress code of the College whenever they are on the Campus - working days, examinations, fests, annual celebrations, special classes and CET classes.

Men (Formal wear)

- Dress material should be the College Uniform with the prescribed stitching pattern
- Shirts should be in formal style (half sleeves only) without any designs or trendy cuts.
- Trousers should be in formal style: full length straight cut, and not in baggy, cargo, low-waist, pencil/carrot cut or in any other style
- The belts, if used, should be of leather, formal in style and black in color.
- Tattoos, ear-rings, pigtails, awkward bracelets, headgears, cowboyish / gypsy appearance, visors, sunglasses, etc., are banned
- Hairstyle must be formal neat, tidy, organized, and well groomed. Hair coloring is not allowed
- Beard should be neatly shaved or *trimmed*. *All types of beard and moustache designs are prohibited*.
- Hiking boots, cowboy boots and gaudy colored footwear are banned

Women (Salwar Kameez)

- Dress material should be the College Uniform with the prescribed stitching pattern
- Tops should be round in 'Nehru collar' style. Deep neck and long slit patterns are banned
- Pants should be formal. Push ups and leggings are banned.
- Stoles, short kurthas, colouring of hair, piercing of body for studding, etc. are not allowed
- Uniform should be prominently displayed. Scarves / head coverings are strictly prohibited.
- Being bedecked in huge jewelry genuine or imitative should be avoided
- Acceptable footwear include: pumps, peep toe, open toe dress shoes, closed and open toe sling backs, open back heels, clogs, loafers, deck shoes, non-athletic walking shoes, dress boots and flats
