- ❖ Weightage for Choreography, Music, Co-ordination & Costume.
- ❖ The decision of the jury will be the ultimate

# Type IV – Western Dance



- ❖ No spot registration.
- ❖ Maximum 7 members are allowed in a team, minimum of 5 members on stage is compulsory.
- ❖ Contestants can choose songs from Kannada, Tulu and Hindi languages.
- ❖ Time limit is 4+1=5 Minutes. There will be negative marks for exceeding the time limit.
- ❖ Weightage for Choreography, Music, Co-ordination & Costume.
- ❖ Participants should select only one song, remix songs are not allowed.
- ❖ Usage of dangerous props like flame, swad, chemicals etc are prohibited
- ❖ The decision of the judges will be the ultimate.
